

B2 ENGLISH TEST – SPRING SUMMER 2023

The test

The purpose of the B2 computerised English test is to evaluate the candidates' knowledge of English. It tests language usage, reading and listening comprehension.

The test lasts around 1 hour and 60% of correct answers is its cut-score.

It will be administered remotely.

Who can sit the test?

The test, which is free of charge, is aimed at those students intending to apply for either the Advanced Automotive Engineering or Electric Vehicle Engineering Master's Degree Course.

Only UNIMORE students and Alumni provided of UNIMORE username and password can sit the test.
